



## Terms & Conditions for Lexus Nottingham Tennis Centre Summer Racket Festival Prize Draw

The Prize draw is being run by the Lexus Nottingham Tennis Centre to raise money for the LTA Tennis Foundation (registered charity number 1148421). The LTA Tennis Foundation is the promoter.

### Eligibility

1. The prize draw is only open to UK residents aged 18 or over.
2. Employees, trustees, and volunteers of the Lexus Nottingham Tennis Centre/LTA/LTA Tennis Foundation, and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter.
3. The Promoter reserves the right to verify eligibility.
4. Each entrant can only enter a maximum of five times.
5. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for entries not successfully completed due to a technical fault of any kind. Participants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions upon entry. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry, or refuse to award the prizes to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

### Opening & Closing Dates

1. The prize draw opens on 13 July 2026.
2. The closing date is 23.59 on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> July.
3. Entries received before 13 July 2026 or after the closing date will not be valid and will not be included in the draw.
